Targeted school violence has increased over the years. Behavioral Threat Assessment is now mandatory in Texas and is recognized as a best practice throughout the country. In order for our team to be effective in identifying concerning behavior and providing early intervention, we need to be able to gather information such as discipline records, suicide or violence risk assessments, anonymous tips, and reports from teachers and staff into one searchable, organized database.

Kaseware has helped us accomplish all of the above. The program has become integral to our district's operations and is now utilized daily by our police department, administrators, and counselors. Our anonymous tip program “Westlake Watch” has become part of our district's culture of safety. Kaseware allows us to manage tips and easily route them to the appropriate staff member for follow-up.

The Challenge

Every school today is navigating an increasingly complex threat landscape, demanding a comprehensive approach to safety and security. Eanes ISD has to contend with this, and additional unique challenges.

In 2019, Texas Senate Bill 11 mandated the establishment of threat assessment teams and standardized procedures, requiring a robust system for data management and documentation for Texas schools. At this time, Eanes ISD lacked a centralized platform to track incidents, relying on disparate sources like Google Forms and paper records, hindering the ability to gain a holistic view of student behavior and potential risks.

This approach created inefficiencies in reporting and hampered communication between school staff, administrators, and law enforcement. Recognizing the need for a more effective solution, Eanes ISD was also looking for a system that:



Could **import all student data** from its Skyward Student Information System, ensuring seamless integration despite legacy processes.



Had the capability to **upload and manage diverse data types**, including photos and videos, while linking them to specific individuals for more comprehensive records.



Offered advanced **access restriction features with customizable permissions** to maintain data security and confidentiality across different user access levels.



Would **modernize their outdated anonymous tip system** by integrating it into a unified reporting platform for streamlined communication and incident management.

Eanes ISD evaluated a few solutions, but ultimately adopted Kaseware's investigative case management platform. Kaseware met their requirements and enabled them to **streamline threat assessments, improve communication and collaboration, and proactively address potential safety concerns.**

How **Kaseware** Helped

For Eanes ISD, Kaseware became their centralized platform for streamlining safety management and bringing incident reporting, threat assessment, and case management together. With Kaseware, Eanes ISD Police Department's 11 officers now had a system that allowed them to generate reports and efficiently track and analyze data, ensuring everyone involved had the same information. Kaseware's automated workflows facilitated communication and timely interventions, enabling the district to address potential safety issues proactively.

From addressing everyday safety concerns to managing more complex incidents, Kaseware has empowered the Eanes ISD Police Department to efficiently document, track, and resolve a wide range of issues, including:



Proactive Safety Measures: Documenting repeated incidents, such as children falling off the same piece of playground equipment, to identify and address potential safety hazards proactively.



Elopement Response: Recording elopements, where students run away from campus, with detailed documentation of events to ensure a clear understanding and response plan.



Threat Monitoring: Tracking and managing threats effectively, ensuring all relevant details are captured and accessible for swift action.



Workplace Accountability: Handling employee-related incidents with thorough documentation to address concerns and maintain workplace safety.



Incident Reporting for Vehicles: Managing bus and vehicle incidents by keeping detailed records of drivers, and photos and videos, for comprehensive incident tracking.



Injury Documentation: Documenting work-related injuries to support accountability and streamline follow-up processes.

By implementing Kaseware, Eanes ISD has fostered a safer and more supportive learning environment. The system's anonymous tip line and public portal empowers students, parents, and community members to report concerns, enhancing communication and enabling proactive intervention.

How Eanes Utilizes Kaseware

Kaseware's implementation in Eanes ISD has significantly enhanced student safety by providing a comprehensive system to increase efficiency in response, and foster a proactive safety culture. Kaseware's ability to centralize data and streamline communication has proven crucial in identifying and addressing potential risks for Eanes ISD, allowing for timely interventions and more informed decision-making. This proactive approach is critical to ensuring students can learn in a safe and supportive environment.

By enabling quicker response times and more effective case management, school staff, administrators, and law enforcement can work collaboratively and address safety concerns promptly. The district's "Westlake Watch" anonymous tip program through Kaseware is a primary example of how collaboration across a 30-square mile area comes to life, bringing in approximately ~500 anonymous tips per year on concerning behavior, such as harassment, drug use, and violence towards others. With the anonymous tip system and public portal, the community can be involved, fostering a shared responsibility for school safety.

This collaborative approach, coupled with proactive intervention and prevention efforts, creates a secure and supportive learning environment where students can thrive.

Kaseware is incredibly proud to have an impact on student safety and believes strongly in the importance of utilizing technology and data-driven insights to create safer schools.

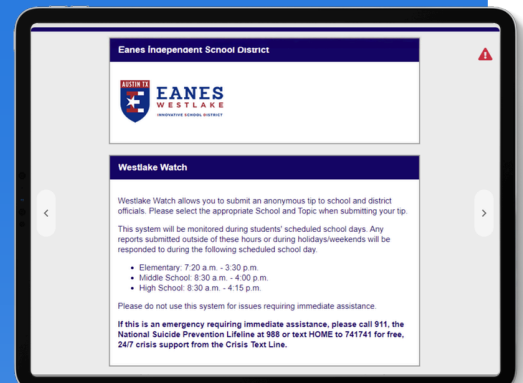
